<b>SUBJECT:</b> 4.11(c)--Award Bid Schedule No. 5069 (Job No. 2645), Replace Asphalt Concrete Surfacing 2019	

### ***Recommendation***

Authorize the following actions relative to Bid Schedule No. 5069 (Job No. 2645), Replace Asphalt Concrete (AC) Surfacing 2019:

- (1) Award to Tullis, Inc. in the amount of \$512,200;
- (2) Approve an additional \$65,000 to cover the cost of contract administration and inspection fees;
- (3) Approve \$70,000 to provide construction contingency funding;
- (4) Approve \$25,000 for project development costs; and
- (5) Authorize the City Manager to approve additional increases, in either the construction management or construction contingency amounts, up to a total of \$15,000.

### ***Fiscal Impact***

The project is funded by the Streets Department and is included in its approved budget for Fiscal Year 2019-20. Project cost components are estimated, and some shifting of the funds may be necessary to balance the project within the approved budget.

**Alternative Action**

The City Council may choose to not award the project, in which case, the streets will continue to deteriorate and require roadway reconstruction.

**Background/Analysis**

A long winter that produced higher than normal precipitation, along with a significant increase in truck traffic due to the Carr Fire repairs, resulted in accelerated surface deterioration of Quartz Hill Road, Buenaventura Boulevard, College View Drive, and Parkview Avenue. This project consists of resurfacing approximately 50,300 cubic feet of asphalt concrete, traffic control, and restriping at various locations within the City of Redding.

Attached is a tabulation of the four bids opened on August 27, 2019. The low bid in the amount of \$512,200 was received from Tullis, Inc. of Redding, California. The engineer's estimate was \$534,150. Total project development costs for this project are estimated to be \$25,000. Project development costs include engineering, environmental, and consultant services (design and construction support).
